# Gather around the prayer space as a family

Parent/Caregiver: In today's gospel, Jesus talks about the way to true happiness.

# **Opening prayer:**

God, you tell us that true joy comes from knowing and loving Jesus.

# Gospel: A reading from the holy gospel according to Luke (6:17, 20-26)

**All:** Glory to you O, Lord.

When Jesus had come down from the hill with the apostles, he stood on a level place with a large number of his disciples. A large crowd of people was there from all over Judea and from Jerusalem and from the coast cities of Tyre and Sidon;

Jesus looked at his disciples and said,

"Happy are you poor; the Kingdom of God is yours!

"Happy are you who are hungry now; you will be filled!

"Happy are you who weep now; you will laugh!

Happy are you when people hate you, reject you, insult you, and say that you are evil, all because of the Son of Man! Be glad when that happens and dance for joy, because a great reward is kept for you in heaven. For their ancestors did the very same things to the prophets.

"But how terrible for you who are rich now; you have had your easy life!

"How terrible for you who are full now; you will go hungry!

"How terrible for you who laugh now; you will mourn and weep!

How terrible when all people speak well of you; their ancestors said the very same things about the false prophets."

I wonder who Jesus was talking about when he said, "Happy are you," ...


I wonder what the disciples were thinking as they listened to Jesus...

**Closing prayer:** We lift our hearts and the prayers of our community. We make these prayers through Christ, our Lord. Amen.
