GUIDELINES TO FOLLOW

FAMILY BACKGROUND

(of yourself and former partner, describe relationships with parents particularly if poor or strained, family problems, brothers/sisters, education level, social interests, and relationships, etc)

2. MEETING YOUR PARTNER

(Describe details of meeting, courtship length of involvement, brief account of the physical appearances of each, sexual involvement, any pressure, did this have any bearing on the decision to marry, pregnancy)

3. THE ENGAGEMENT TIME

(Describe how the topic of engagement arose and the circumstances of the proposal, any pressure involved in the decision to marry, if so from whom. Any infidelities in courtship/engagement. Attitude of friends and family to the decision to marry)

4. THE WEDDING CEREMONY AND RECEPTION

(Describe attitudes to marriage preparation and ceremony, any strange incidents, etc. Did both parties intend permanence, fidelity and children)

THE HONEYMOON

(Describe whether it was happy, any difficulties associated with consummation etc, any signs of future trouble)

6. MARRIED LIFE TOGETHER

(Describe year by year the events of the marriage, communication difficulties, problems that arose, efforts to resolve problems, reason for separation, reconciliations, medical or counseling assistance, etc)

- 7. REASONS WHICH LED TO BREAKDOWN (Describe why you think the marriage failed, etc)
- 8. THE FINAL SEPARATION (Describe what brought it about and how it happened, etc)
- 9. What has happened to you and your partner since the marriage breakdown?

NOTE: It is important, while writing from the guidelines to include any examples of the following:

<u>Irresponsibility or immaturity</u> in you or your partner (e.g. financial, attitude to having a family, sex life, sex outside marriage)

<u>Deviant behaviour</u> in you or your partner (e.g. violence, or cruelty, excessive drinking or drug abuse, dishonesty or gambling, frequent moodiness or outbursts of anger and whether these were observable before the marriage)

<u>Psychological problems</u> in you or your partner (e.g. treatment for emotional or psychiatric disorders, irrational behaviour or marked lack of self control)

<u>PLEASE SIGN AND DATE YOUR WRITTEN STATEMENT</u> before you send your application into the Tribunal Office. Thank you.

NOTE

- ***** For preliminary assessment of your application for a Decree of Nullity, the Tribunal relies heavily on this written statement/history. Please be as comprehensive as possible in your statement. Very briefly or sketchy statements about the pre-marriage time make it difficult to give a positive assessment.
- **** Complete and return the enclosed witness sheet, together with requested documents (as per front of witness sheet).
- **** The fee payable for the formal annulment case is \$770.00. This fee only covers about one quarter of what it costs to process the case from beginning to end as it is a very labour intensive task. If you are genuinely unable to meet our fees, your application can proceed provided you let us know and special arrangements can be made.

You may wish to pay the full fee of \$770.00 at the beginning of the case.

Others may prefer to pay in 4 instalments as follows:-

- \$200.00 on presentation of your application
- \$200.00 when you give formal testimony
- \$200.00 when all your witnesses have been interviewed
- a final \$170.00 when you have been advised your case has been judged in the First Instance by the Regional Tribunal.
