

CHRISTMAS CANDLE HOLDER

MATFRIALS:

Empty margarine container
Length of ribbon
Household candle
Gum nuts and leaves
Tufts of red tinsel
Craft glue
Stapler
Scissors

INSTRUCTIONS:

- Turn margarine container upside down and cut a cross in the centre. (This is best done with a Stanley knife so should be pre-prepared for children) Take care to make the cut just large enough to hold your candle firmly.
- 2. Cut a length of ribbon and wrap around the outside of the container and fix with staples.
- 3. Place candle through the cut so that it stands securely.
- 4. Arrange leaves and gum nuts around the base of candle so that surface is covered. Fix with craft glue.
- 5. Place tufts of tinsel among the nuts and leaves. These might need to be secured with a little extra craft glue.
