Gather around the prayer space as a family

Parent/Caregiver: In today's gospel, Jesus speaks about the food of eternal life.

Opening prayer:

Lord Jesus, you gave us the gift of your teachings and you give us food that will nourish us and give us strength. Help us to follow you in faith, each day of our lives. Amen

Gospel: A reading from the holy gospel according to John (6:24-29)

All: Glory to you O, Lord.

The people saw that Jesus and his disciples had left. Then they got into boats and went to Capernaum to look for Jesus. They found him on the west side of the lake and asked, "Rabbi, when did you get here?"

I tell you for certain that you are not looking for me because you saw the miracles, but because you ate all the food you wanted. Don't work for food that spoils. Work for food that gives eternal life. The Son of Man will give you this food, because God the Father has given him the right to do so."

"What exactly does God want us to do?" the people asked. Jesus answered, "God wants you to have faith in the one he sent."

Scripture reflection and time of sharing:

Lord, hear us. All: Lord, hear our prayer

Closing prayer: We lift up our prayers and the prayers of our community. We make these prayers through Christ, our Lord. Amen.
