# Preparing the prayer space

Place a green cloth on the table or floor (green – the colour for Ordinary Time)

Place a cross, bible, and candle on it. Light the candle or use a battery-operated candle for safety. Add any other symbols relevant to your family.

- Suggested activities: your choice or other related activity on sheet
- · Print out sheet if required

#### Gather around the prayer space as a family

Parent/Caregiver: In today's gospel, Jesus tells his disciples what to do to enter God's kingdom.

## **Opening prayer:**

Lord God, help us to become humbler by putting you first. Allow us to use the gifts you give to us to help others instead of keeping them for ourselves.

# Gospel: A reading from the holy gospel according to Mark (10:17-27)

All: Glory to you O, Lord.

As Jesus was walking down a road, a man ran up to him. He kneeled down, and asked, "Good teacher, what can I do to have eternal life?"

Jesus replied, "Why do you call me good? Only God is good. You know the commandments. 'Do not murder. Be faithful in marriage. Do not steal. Do not tell lies about others. Do not cheat. Respect your father and mother."

The man answered, "Teacher, I have obeyed all these commandments since I was a young man."

Jesus looked closely at the man. He liked him and said, "There's one thing you still need to do. Go sell everything you own. Give your money to the poor, and you will have riches in heaven. Then come with me."

When the man heard Jesus say this, he went away gloomy and sad because he was very rich.

Jesus looked around and said to his disciples, "It's hard for rich people to get into God's kingdom!" The disciples were shocked to hear this. So Jesus told them again, "It's terribly hard to get into God's kingdom! In fact, it is easier for a camel to go through the eye of a needle than for a rich person to get into God's kingdom."

We pause for a moment and pray in our hearts or aloud for any intentions or people we would like to pray for at this time (pause)

We pray for all those who feel anxious and feel burdened, that they may find peace in Jesus.

Lord, hear us. All: Lord, hear our prayer
