## Gather around the prayer space as a family

Parent/Caregiver: In today's gospel, Jesus tells us that things may change but God's love for us is never changing and unending.

#### **Opening prayer:**

Lord God no matter what changes come in our lives, may we always remember your love for us will stay the same and last forever.

## Gospel: A reading from the holy gospel according to Mark (13:24-32)

**All:** Glory to you O, Lord.

Jesus said to his disciples: "In those days, right after that time of suffering, 'The sun will become dark, and the moon will no longer shine. The stars will fall, and the powers in the sky will be shaken.'

"Then the Son of Man will be seen coming in the clouds with great power and glory. He will send his angels to gather his chosen ones from all over the earth.

"Learn a lesson from a fig tree. When its branches sprout and start putting out leaves, you know summer is near. So when you see all these things happening, you will know that the time has almost come. You can be sure that some of the people living today will still be alive when all of this happens.

The sky and the earth will not last forever, but my words will.

"No one knows the day or the time. The angels in heaven don't know and the Son himself doesn't know. Only the Father knows."
