Gather around the prayer space as a family

Parent/Caregiver: In today's gospel, Jesus is asking us to be ready for him.

Opening prayer:

Lord God, prepare our hearts and fill them with love so that we can be ready to receive you wholeheartedly.

Gospel: A reading from the holy gospel according to Luke (21:25-28, 34-36)

All: Glory to you O, Lord.

Jesus said to his disciples: "Strange things will happen to the sun, moon, and stars. The nations on earth will be afraid of the roaring sea and tides, and they won't know what to do. People will be so frightened that they will faint because of what is happening to the world. Every power in the sky will be shaken.

"Then the Son of Man will be seen, coming in a cloud with great power and glory. When all of this starts happening, stand up straight and be brave. You will soon be set free.

"Don't spend all of your time thinking about eating or drinking or worrying about life. If you do, the final day will suddenly catch you like a trap. That day will surprise everyone on earth.

"Watch out and keep praying that you can escape all that is going to happen and that the Son of Man will pleased with you."

The gospel of the Lord.

All: Praise to you, Lord Jesus Christ.

2 We pray for all families, that they will find joy and peace in their homes.

Lord, hear us. **All:** Lord, hear our prayer

3 We pray for the members of our Church may spread faith, hope, and love with others this Advent season.

Lord, hear us. **All:** Lord, hear our prayer

4 We pause for a moment and pray in our hearts or aloud for any intentions or people we would like to pray for at this time (*pause*)

Lord, hear us. **All:** Lord, hear our prayer

6 We pray for those who have suffered much pain, may they find healing and peace in Jesus.

Lord, hear us. **All:** Lord, hear our prayer
