Gather around the prayer space as a family

Parent/Caregiver: In today's gospel, we hear that Elizabeth's baby leaps with joy at the presence of Mary who is carrying the baby Jesus in her womb.

Opening prayer:

Loving God, help us to trust in your plans and to remember that you will always keep your promises.

Gospel: A reading from the holy gospel according to Luke (1:39-45)

All: Glory to you O, Lord.

Mary hurried to a town in the hill country of Judea. She went into Zechariah's home, where she greeted Elizabeth. When Elizabeth heard Mary's greeting, her baby moved within her.

The Holy Spirit came upon Elizabeth. Then in a loud voice she said to Mary:

"God has blessed you more than any other woman! He has also blessed the child you will have. Why should the mother of my Lord come to me? As soon as I heard your greeting, my baby became happy and moved within me.

The Lord has blessed you because you believed that he will keep his promise."

The gospel of the Lord.

All: Praise to you, Lord Jesus Christ.

Scripture reflection and time of sharing:

I wonder how I can be like Mary and share joy with others...

Intercessions: Let us now spend some time in prayer asking God to listen to our needs. (We respond to the prayers by saying the words 'Lord, hear our prayer')

Lord, hear us. All: Lord, hear our prayer

We pray for all families who experience brokenness and separation, that they will find a sense of peace and hope this Advent.

Lord, hear us. All: Lord, hear our prayer

We pray for our Church to be missionary disciples like Mary and visit those who need us, especially the sick, lonely, and poor in our community.

Lord, hear us. All: Lord, hear our prayer

We pause for a moment and pray in our hearts or aloud for any intentions or people we would like to pray for at this time (*pause*)

Lord, hear us. All: Lord, hear our prayer

We pray for those are suffering or experiencing big challenges, that the Holy Spirit will bring them comfort and peace.

Lord, hear us. All: Lord, hear our prayer

Closing prayer: We lift our hearts and the prayers of our community. We make these prayers through Christ, our Lord. Amen.
